INDICATIONS:

PROPRIETARY NAME AND PHARMACEUTICAL FORM:

Sanvitone 10 / 30 Capsules

Read this leaflet carefully before you start taking Sanvitone.

Sanvitone is available without a doctor's prescription to treat a mild condition. Regardless thereof, you still need to use Sanvitone in accordance with the instructions for safe end efficient use.

- Do not share Sanvitone with any other person.
- Ask your pharmacist if you need more information or advice.
- You must see a doctor if your symptoms do not improve.

WHAT SANVITONE CONTAINS:

Each capsule contains:

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Lycopene 10%	500 µg
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WHAT SANVITONE IS USED FOR:

Sanvitone contains ingredients which have shown to reduce oxidative stress in the lungs. Studies indicate that deficiency of ingredients contained in Sanvitone may cause or worsen conditions associated with lower respiratory infections, asthma and COPD.

Sanvitone is indicated to reduce oxidative stress in the lungs by balancing antioxidant / free radical ratio.

BEFORE YOU TAKE SANVITONE:

Carefully read this information leaflet and make sure that you are not allergic to any of the ingredients contained in Sanvitone.

Do not take Sanvitone if you are hypersensitive to any of the ingredients contained in Sanvitone.

TAKE SPECIAL CARE WITH SANVITONE:

Take Sanvitone 2 hours before or after taking any other medication.

TAKING SANVITONE WITH FOOD OR DRINK:

Do not take Sanvitone on an empty stomach. Take Sanvitone before or after a meal with at least 300ml of water.

PREGNANCY & BREASTFEEDING:

Safety during pregnancy and breastfeeding has not been established. Please consult your healthcare professional.

TAKING OTHER MEDICATION WITH SANVITONE:

Always inform your healthcare professional when you start or intend to start taking new medication. This includes complimentary or traditional medicine.

Sanvitone should not replace any existing prescribed medication for any condition.

HOW TO TAKE SANVITONE:

Take 1 capsule daily, before or after a meal with at least 300ml of water.

IF YOU HAVE TAKEN / ADMINISTERED MORE SANVITONE THAN YOU SHOULD HAVE:

Common symptoms of overdosage may include headache, nausea, vomiting and or diarrhea. If you encounter any of these symptoms after taking too much Sanvitone, contact your doctor, hospital, or nearest poison control center.

IF YOU MISSED OR FAILED TO ADMINISTER A DOSE OF SANVITONE:

Do not take double the dose to make up for the missed dose.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

No side-effects have been reported and side-effects should only occur if you have taken Sanvitone without checking whether you are allergic to any of the ingredients.

Allergic reactions to Sanvitone may include headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or difficulty breathing. If you encounter any of these side-effects contact your doctor immediately.

If you notice any other side-effects not listed herein please inform your pharmacist and/or doctor.

STORING AND DISPOSING OF SANVITONE:

Store Sanvitone out of direct sunlight in a cool dry place below 25°C. keep out of reach of children. Return all unused medicine to your pharmacy. Do not dispose of unused medicine in drains or sewerage systems.
